In addition to the Wellbeing grid we have created for you this week, we would like you to have a go at these Be Internet Awesome activities. Be Internet Awesome is the scheme we use in Key Stage 2 at Adamsdown Primary school to encourage children to be Smart, Strong, Alert, Brave and Kind online.


Be Internet Awesome uses the Online world of <u>Interland</u> to develop the digital literacy of children in a creative and imaginative way.

There are four levels to **Interland**:

- Reality River
- Mindful Mountain
- Tower of Treasure
- Kind Kingdom

For each level, the children need to look at the Google Slide **first** and then access <u>Interland</u> to apply their knowledge.

1) Reality River



Be Internet ALERT

Don't fall for fake! Children need to be able to discern between what is real and what is fake online. This lesson will teach them to spot the differences, and spot clues in fake emails and websites.

Personal privacy and online security are very important! This lesson teaches children the importance of online security, how to create strong passwords and the importance of never sharing personal information online.
