<p><u>Literacy 1</u></p>  <p>Think of a hero to be in your story.</p> <p>Draw a picture of your hero – write adjectives around your picture to describe how your hero looks and his personality i.e. Brave, responsible, heroic.</p>	<p><u>Literacy 2</u></p> <p>Think of a villain to be in your story.</p> <p>Draw a picture of your villain – write adjectives around your picture to describe how your villain looks and what their personality is like i.e. angry, suspicious, nasty, cunning</p>	<p><u>Literacy 3</u></p> <p>Write a story based on these two characters.</p> <p>Remember to have an introduction, middle and end.</p> <p>Introduction – introduce the characters Middle – what is the problem? End – hero fixes the problem and destroys the villain</p>
<p><u>Mathematics 1</u></p> <p>Find equivalent fractions to a $\frac{1}{2}$ Remember equivalent means equal to or same as</p> <p>e.g. $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{5}{10} = \frac{3}{6}$</p>	<p><u>Mathematics 2</u></p> <p>Find equivalent fractions to $\frac{1}{4}$.</p> <p>E.g. $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{5}{20} = \frac{4}{16}$</p>	<p><u>Mathematics 3</u></p> <p>Find equivalent fractions to $\frac{1}{3}$.</p> <p>E.g. $\frac{1}{3} = \frac{5}{15} = \frac{2}{6}$</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Explain how the digestive system works.</p> <p>Where does the digestive first take place? Where does it end?</p> <p>You can draw and label a human body too to help you explain!</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Research about ancient romans.</p> <p>When did the Romans first come about?</p> <p>Who were some of the main emperors?</p> <p>What food did they eat?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Compare the weather of Wales to that of Brazil.</p> <p>What country has more rain each year?</p> <p>What months are the hottest in Brazil and Wales?</p> <p>What months are the coldest in Brazil and Wales?</p> <p>Why do you think one country has more rain than the other?</p>
