Health and Wellbeing

Think about what you have been doing at home since our school closed. What have you enjoyed about being at home? What fun things have you been doing at home to keep busy?

Write a list or draw the positives that you have found since being at home e.g. My family and I have found lots of different walks around my local area since being off school, that was really fun!



Health and Wellbeing

You have been given the task from Mrs Bowen to improve the school garden. Decorate a pebble which will be placed in the school garden for everyone to see. Decorate the pebble with positive pictures e.g. a rainbow, flowers, the school logo and name. It is up to you! Try and make it as exciting and colourful as you can!

Keep the pebbles and bring them back to school so Mrs Bowen can put them in the garden.



Numeracy

Play the game 'Lines'. See below the grid for the instructions.

- You can use any coloured counters/objects (as long as each player uses a different colour)
- Remember a multiple is a number that is in a given times table (eg the multiples of 3 are 3, 6, 9, 12 etc)

Lines

1. Each player chooses a number.
2. Players take turns to place their counters on the grid.
3. Once a player has placed their counter, they must say a multiple of their chosen number.
4. The first player to get 5 counters in a row (horizontally, vertically or diagonally) wins.

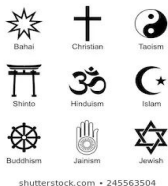
